Fire Chief Bittenger talked about a new reporting software for Fire/EMS. The system is called ESO. University Hospital will pay the annual charge but the township will be responsible for the set up fee of \$312.00.

The annual Fire/EMS awards banquet is set for March 7th with a start time of 6:00pm with food at 6:30pm which will be provided by the Mifflin Lions Club.
